- o Schools open September 3, 2020
- Hybrid Instruction
 - In-person two full days and remote learning three days
- o Remote learning available as full-time option, registration required
- Masks are required for staff and students
- o Daily health screening required for ACPS students and staff
- Enhanced cleaning protocols
- o Approval of COVID-19 protocols by New Jersey Department of Health



Staff and students will wear masks throughout the school day when unable to maintain social distancing. It is suggested that younger students practice wearing masks for extended periods now.



Staff and students will be asked to wash their hands frequently and will have routine handwashing breaks throughout the school day.



Staff and students will maintain a safe distance.
Students will be reminded to keep hands to themselves with no high-fives, hugs or shared school supplies.
