- **Preschool:**

- [Preschool Hybrid/Remote Rosters and Schedule Sheet](#)
- There are two models for preschool: Hybrid and Full Remote.
- *Hybrid model* follows A schedule (Monday & Wednesday) & B schedule (Tuesday & Thursday); Friday is a remote day for all students and one-on-one make-up day.
 - 8:15 am - 12:45 pm (synchronous)
- *Full remote model* requires students to attend Monday through Thursday.
 - 9:00 am - 11:30 am
- **In-Person Instruction** follows the half day schedule below.
- **Hybrid at Home Learning Days**, except Fridays, are limited to one hour of live instruction and additional virtual work, which includes recorded model lessons.
- **Full Remote Learning**, except Fridays, are limited to one hour of live instruction, a 10-15 min. One-on-one session for literacy and math on selected days and additional virtual work, which includes recorded model lessons.
- *In-person students* will be assigned to a classroom teacher.
- *Hybrid at home learning days students and Full Remote students* will be assigned to a Full Remote Teacher.
- No specials for preschool.
- Technology: Devices remain at home for virtual learning. Students **will not** carry devices to school. Preschool students will engage in hands-on activities during in-person instruction.

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- **Grades K-2:**

- There are two models: Hybrid and Full Remote.

- Students are re-rostered between teachers designated as Hybrid teachers (two teachers in most cases) and a Full Remote teacher.
- Hybrid model follows an A (Monday & Wednesday) and B (Tuesday & Thursday) schedule. Please see In Person/Remote Instruction Chart for Fridays.
 - Hybrid at Home Learning Days include recorded and assigned lessons.
 - In-person instruction follows the half day schedule below.
- Full Remote learning is for students whose parents selected this model in the survey.
- Specialists will post assignments in Google Classrooms daily to be completed at home (**full remote and at-home hybrid students**).
- Technology: Student devices will remain at home for virtual learning. Students **will not** carry devices to school. A device will be assigned to each student during in-person instruction.
- **BSI, Reading Recovery, LLI, Gifted & Talented, ESL, and instructional support teachers will not physically push into grade level classrooms; they will work with their groups using a synchronous model via GoGuardian. K-2 has headphones with microphones. Additional headsets with microphones have been ordered.**

- **Grades 3-8:**
 - ***There is one instructional model: Synchronous Learning Model***
 - Synchronous Learning follows an A (Monday & Wednesday) and B (Tuesday & Thursday) schedule. Students whose parents selected full remote will be learning from home.
 - The number of students in each cohort should be balanced between teachers designated as Hybrid Synchronous teachers (three teachers in most cases). Students are designated as Cohort A, B and Full Remote (C). All students who are learning at home, will log on daily to the live instruction.
 - Please see In Person/Remote Instruction Chart for Fridays.
 - Synchronous learning: the cohorts that are **not** in school are using their Chromebooks to sign on to **live** instruction with the teacher and classmates who **are** in school. The teacher is instructing daily.
 - Cameras have been purchased to facilitate teacher lesson delivery.
 - Technology: Students in grades 3-12 will carry their devices to and from school.
 - [Specials](#) will follow *Hybrid Remote Day schedules*.
 - **BSI, System 44, Read 180, Gifted & Talented, and other interventionists will not physically push into grade level classrooms; they will work with their groups using a synchronous model via GoGuardian.**

- **Grades 9-12:**
 - ***There is one instructional model: Synchronous Learning Model***
 - Synchronous Learning follows A (Monday & Wednesday) and B (Tuesday & Thursday) schedule. Students whose parents selected full remote will be learning from home.
 - Students are designated as Cohort A, B and Full Remote. All students who are learning at home, will log on daily to the live instruction.
 - Please see In Person/Remote Instruction Chart for Fridays.
 - Synchronous learning: the cohorts that are **not** in school are using their Chromebooks to sign on to **live** instruction with the teacher and classmates who **are** in school. The teacher is instructing daily.
 - Cameras have been purchased to facilitate teacher lesson delivery.
 - Technology: Students in grades 3-12 will carry their devices to and from school.
 - Gifted & Talented at a specific class period will work with their groups via GoGuardian and select learning management systems (LMS).

Full Remote Model

- **A full remote teacher only exists in grades K-2. In grades 3-12, students whose parents selected Full Remote will be learning synchronously.**
 - Parents selected Full Remote Instruction for Marking Period 2 with district survey.
- A designated teacher is assigned for full remote students at home.
 - Kindergarten instruction is delivered in two groups; 8:15am-10:30 am & 11:15am-1:30pm (teacher lunch 10:30-11:00)
 - Grades 1-2 instruction follows the in-person half day schedule.
 - Please see In Person/Remote Instruction Chart for Fridays.
 - Specialists will post assignments in Google Classrooms daily to be completed at home.
