Title I/III Summer School is **"Off to an Adventure"** and we invite your child to join us for breakfast, lunch, and adventures on **Monday, July 2, 2018, through Thursday, July 26, 2018, from 8:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. (no classes on Fridays, July 4th, and July 5th).**

### "Off to an Adventure"

**Pre K:** Students will build on foundational skills through engaging activities in English Language Arts and Mathematics.

**Reader's Theater and iRead (Kindergarten):** Matt didn't like bugs! In fact, he wished they would all just bug off. *Bug Off!* is an "Early Reader" story presented in rhyme for Stage 1 and 2 readers. Students will participate in a series of Reader's Theaters and experiments that focus on English Language Arts and STEM.

**Pirate's Adventure (grades 1-3):** Yo ho ho, it's a pirate's life for me! Students will transform into pirates as they work together to navigate the high seas. They will use STEM-focused science experiments and work with their crew to build catapults, tie knots, make maps, and find hidden treasures!

**Traveling Artists (grades 4-5):** Students will survey the world of art by carving totem poles in the Pacific Northwest, crafting Aztec masks in the heart of Mexico and experimenting with the artistic traditions of history. In this thrilling camp, students get creative examining STEM processes that make art possible, like the delicate balance of water tension involved in Japanese Suminagashi paper or the cultural traditions and paleontology of Chinese "dragons".

**Eggs-Traordinary Physics (grades 6-7):** Students will spin, toss, race, and design egg transport systems. This eggciting camp pushes design challenges to create interactive projects that will turn any student into a physicist!

**iRead (grades K-2):** As iReaders, students will use engaging technology to master foundational reading skills.

**Visual and Performing Arts Cabaret (grades 3-8):** Students focus on traditional English Language and Visual Performing Arts as they transform into singers, dancers, actors, and comedians and bring to life an artistic cabaret.


