GENERAL INFORMATION

BUILDING MAINTENANCE

Maintenance and repairs to the building will be in progress during school. Maintenance in the instructional area of the school will occur after school hours. Students are only permitted in the areas designated on their schedules. Students are not to be in any unauthorized areas. Shoes and proper clothing must be worn at all times.

FIRE DRILLS

Fire drills will be conducted during summer school. The fire exits closest to the classrooms will be used. Students will proceed in an orderly fashion to the designated areas where roll will be taken. Your classroom teachers will provide detailed fire drill procedures periodically throughout the summer session.

SCHOOL NURSE

The health office will be open during summer school. All concerns that demand medical attention must be documented with the school nurse in room G200. All documentation must be submitted by the first day of school, or as soon as applicable.

LOCKERS

Students DO NOT have access to lockers during summer school. All articles found in lockers will be discarded.

LOST and FOUND

Students are encouraged NOT to bring personal items of great value to school. A lost and found department will be maintained in H217.

LAVATORIES

Students are permitted to use the lavatories located in the instructional areas only. Teacher authorization is required in the form of a hall pass.

TRANSPORTATION

Parking is available for students. Bicycles are not permitted in the building. Students who ride bicycles to school must store their bicycles OUTSIDE the building. Students are encouraged to lock their bicycles, as the school assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen bicycles.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

REMEDIATION

As per state guidelines, students are permitted to receive credit for courses previously failed if they successfully complete sixty (60) hours of remediation in an approved summer school program. **Therefore, one absence will result in removal from the program.**

Summer School will be **in-person only**. Students will not be able to attend remotely.

TUITION AND FEES

NO TUITION applies for legal residents of Atlantic City.

ALL NON-RESIDENTS (Sending Districts Only - Longport, Margate, Ventnor, and Brigantine) will NOT BE CHARGED TUITION.

EXAMINATIONS

Students should be prepared for frequent testing. Teachers may give a midterm examination before the interim report. Final examinations will be given in all subjects during the last week of summer school.

TEXTBOOK AND SUPPLIES

Textbooks are provided for students enrolled in the summer program. Students are required to complete the necessary textbook cards. **Students are responsible for proper care of textbooks and other issued materials. Final report cards and transcripts will not be issued to students who have an obligation.** Students are expected to bring pens, pencils, and notebooks to class as needed.

SUMMER SCHOOL REGULATIONS

- (a) Students are to use the main entrance. Upon entering the building students must go directly to class.
- (b) Outside preparation for class is required of all students in order to complete the necessary work. All students must plan in advance to devote a considerable portion of their time to study outside of the regular Summer School hours.
- (c) Proper classroom behavior is required of all students. Failure to participate in class, lack of homework assignments, sleeping in class, or disruptive behavior are grounds for removal from class.
- (d) Atlantic City Board of Education and ACHS policies and regulations are enforced during summer school. Students must be properly attired in order to ensure a climate conducive to learning. However, students may wear shorts to school. Shoes must be worn at all times while in the building.
- (e) Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the building or on school grounds. Violation of this rule will result in immediate dismissal from Summer School.
- (f) Students are not permitted to bring any type of musical playback or broadcast device to Summer School (phones, MP3 players, iPods, radios, CD players, etc.). Such devices will be confiscated and be returned at the discretion of the Director.
- (g) Students under the influence of, trafficking in, or in possession of drugs or alcohol while in Summer School will be dismissed immediately.
- (h) The use of profanity or abusive language will not be tolerated in Summer School. Students may be removed from class or school as a result of this behavior.
- (i) Food or beverages are not permitted anywhere in the building.
- (j) In general, regulations that apply to the regular school session will also apply in Summer School.

ATTENDANCE

- (a) One absence from summer school will constitute removal from ACHS Summer School.**
- (b) Student disciplinary infractions will not be tolerated, suspension is applicable as well as removal from Summer School.**
