ACT® is working on an online version of the national ACT® test. As part of that development effort, they are conducting the ACT April Online Study on **April 4, 2020** and our Atlantic City High School Juniors have been given opportunity to participate for FREE.

Atlantic City High school will be able to offer their students in 11th grade the chance to **take the ACT for free, with college-reportable scores.**

Reasons to Participate

- Your student in grade 11 can take the ACT for free and receive college-reportable scores. ACT will waive the registration fee for the ACT or the ACT with Writing for participating ACHS students.
- Participating schools will be part of an important research study and gain helpful experience with online testing.
- Your student will be among the first to use our upcoming platform for test registration and score reporting.

Additional Information

- This study involves Atlantic City High School administering **both online and paper versions** of the ACT test.
- Online testing will occur on **school-provided Chromebooks**. Students cannot use their own personal devices.
- ACT will provide payment vouchers for students at Atlantic City High School to register online for the April 4, 2020 test date.
- ACT will randomly assign students from Atlantic City High School to either the online or paper test.
- Bus transportation may be available for students (dependent on approval).
