Applications will open on our website starting at midnight and stay open for 24 hours or until we reach the allotted number of applications given out.

Thursday February 1, 2024 – February 9, 2023 (100 applications)

Applications are on a first come first serve basis.

Applicants must be at least 17 years of age at the time of application and hold a valid NJ driver's license and will be 18 years of age prior to being indentured by the JATC.

After successfully submitting your application you will be emailed a link to upload the required documents needed to complete your application. Failure to submit your documents will void your application.

- 1. Valid New Jersey Driver's License;
- 2. Valid proof of birth date; examples valid driver's license, birth certificate, or other State ID
- 3. High School Diploma or High School Equivalency (GED) Certificate and official report of test results
- 4. Unofficial High School and Post High School Education and Training Transcript.

5. Military Transfer or Discharge Form DD-214, if applicable.

Prior applicants must resubmit the above documents. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Recruitment, selection, employment and training will be without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin of sex. Female and minority applicants are encouraged to apply.

Applicants must reside in and have been bona fide resident of the geographical jurisdiction of Local Union 322 for one year prior to making application. This includes all of Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, Ocean, and Salem Counties.

NOTE: In the event that you do not have online access we encourage you to visit your local library or contact Local Union 322 directly.

Applicants will be required to complete an online assessment as well as an in-person proctored math exam. This information will be emailed to the email you provided on your application after our application process closes on February 9, 2024.

If you are accepted into UA Local 322 Apprenticeship Program you must then apply for and receive a TWIC (Transportation Worker Identification Card) prior to beginning work. You can apply at http://www.tsa.gove/for-industry/twic. You will be reimbursed for the cost of the card when received. We will need a receipt and copy of your card for reimbursement.
