BEFORE WE BEGIN...A LITTLE REFRESHER CONTINUED

- **When reviewing scores over a period of time**
 - **Follow grades of students from grade level to grade level so that you are viewing the same students for growth**
 - **Looking at a grade level over time is not looking at the same students**
- **8th grade Math scores are affected by students taking the Algebra 1 PARCC**
- **High school scores do not include students who are taking AP Classes**
- **PARCC reporting is using new numbers for the first time since 2014-2015**
- **State Performance Indicators focusing on Student Growth as opposed to just Scores**
- **Presentation will be viewable on the district website beginning tomorrow**

DISTRICT HIGHLIGHTS

- 4 of our schools came out of RAC status at the end of 2016-2017 when they met their target goals and/or showed growth
 - ACHS
 - Martin Luther King Complex
 - Sovereign Avenue
 - Texas Avenue
- From 2016-2018 we have seen in Grade 5
 - An increase in Levels 4 and 5 in both ELA and Math
 - A decrease in Levels 1 and 2

- From 2016-2018 The district's Algebra I percentage for Levels 4 and 5 show an increase and Levels 1 and 2 have decreased by 9.3%. This has been helped by the 8th graders who are taking the Algebra I PARCC exam with success.
- Algebra 1 Levels at Richmond (86.4%), Sovereign (88.5%) and Uptown (100%)
- and Texas Avenue (63.3%), Martin Luther King Complex (55.6%)

DISTRICT HIGHLIGHTS CONTINUED

- **The district is sharing the goal of reducing absenteeism (reducing Chronic Absenteeism)**

- **Richmond Avenue is the only school that is below the state average for Chronic Absenteeism**
- **Pennsylvania Avenue and Uptown School Complex developed innovative plans to reduce absenteeism**
- **The district has developed an SOP for attendance procedures; as well as, following policy and statute in dealing with students/parents when students are absent**

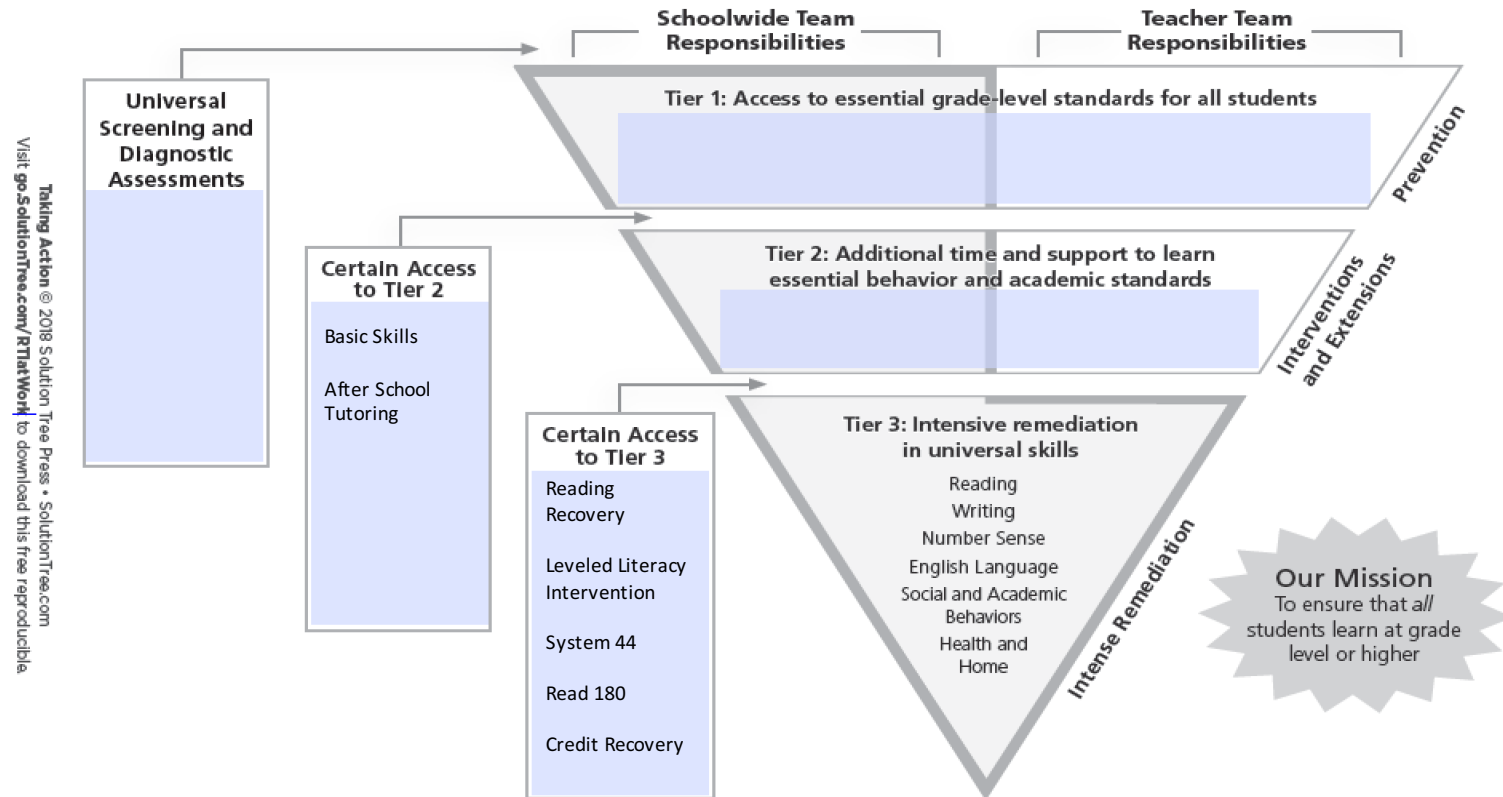
- **NJQSAC Meeting at the county office of NJDOE**

DISTRICT CHALLENGES

- From 2016-2018 Grade 11 for ELA and Algebra II and Geometry at the high school are not showing an increase in Levels 4 and 5 and; unfortunately, are showing increases in levels 1 and 2
- From 2016 to 2018 in ELA the greatest challenges are in Grades
 - 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11
- From 2016 to 2018 in Math the greatest challenges are in Grades
 - 1, 6, 7, 8, Algebra II, Geometry

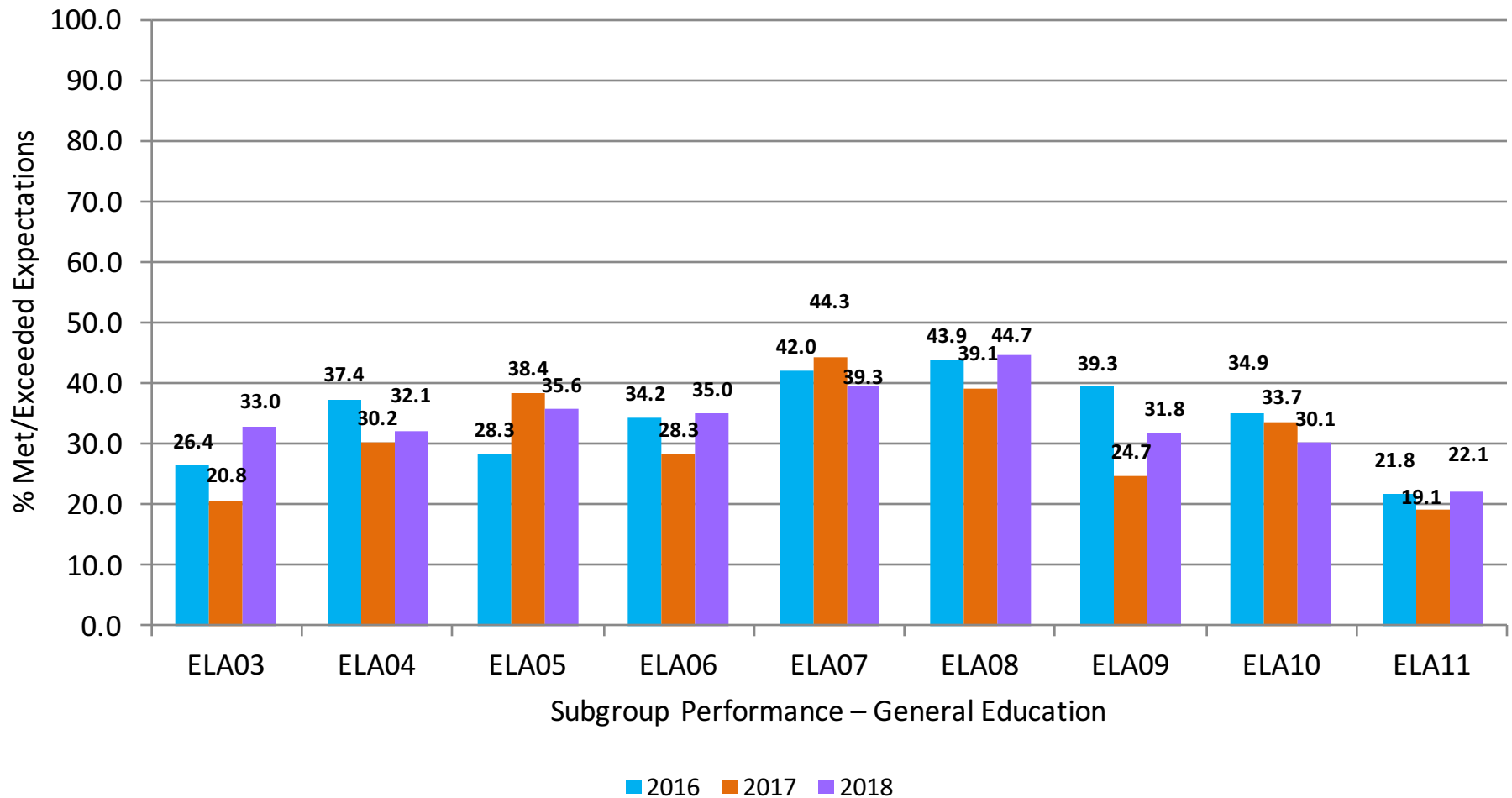

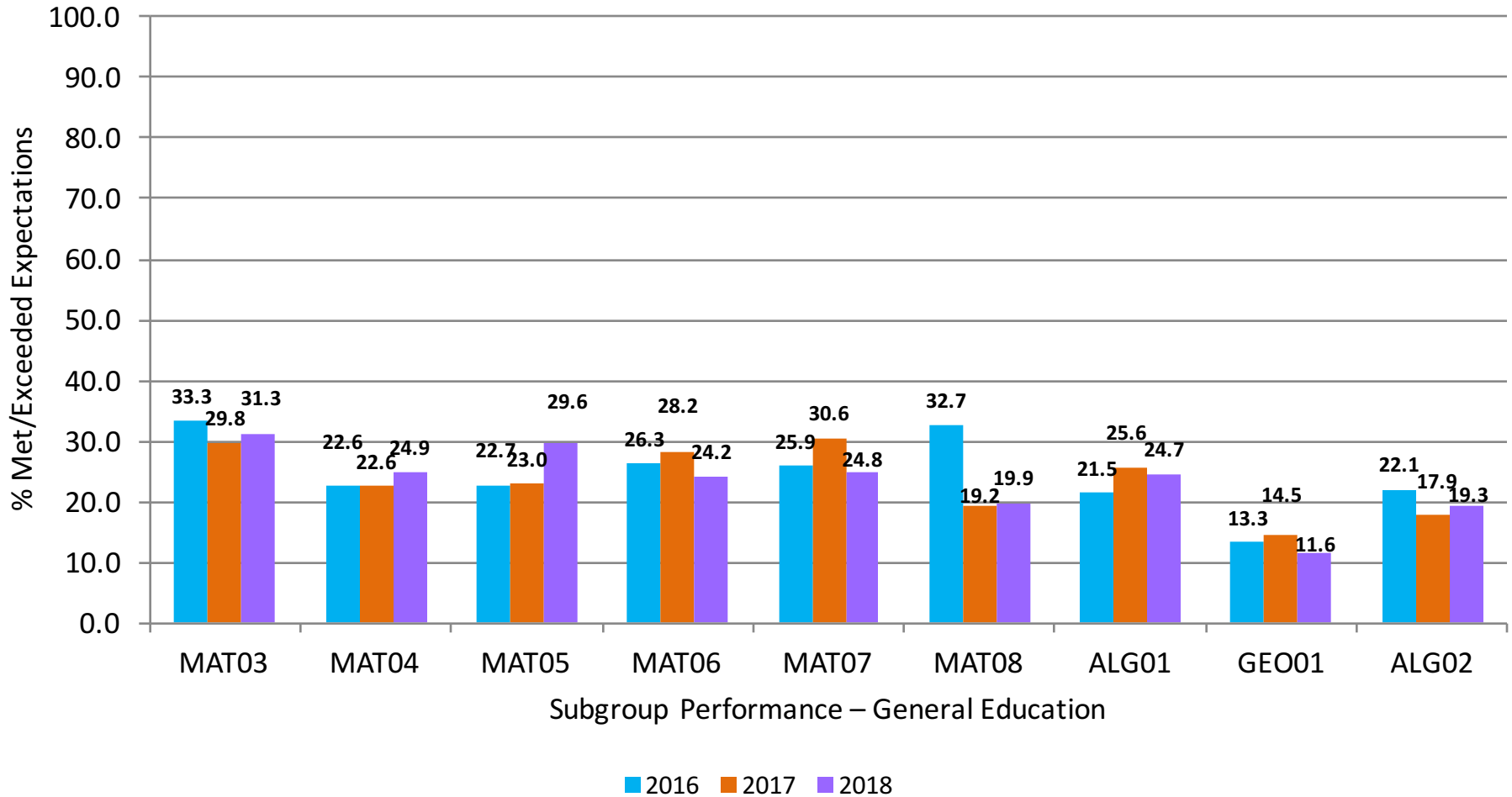

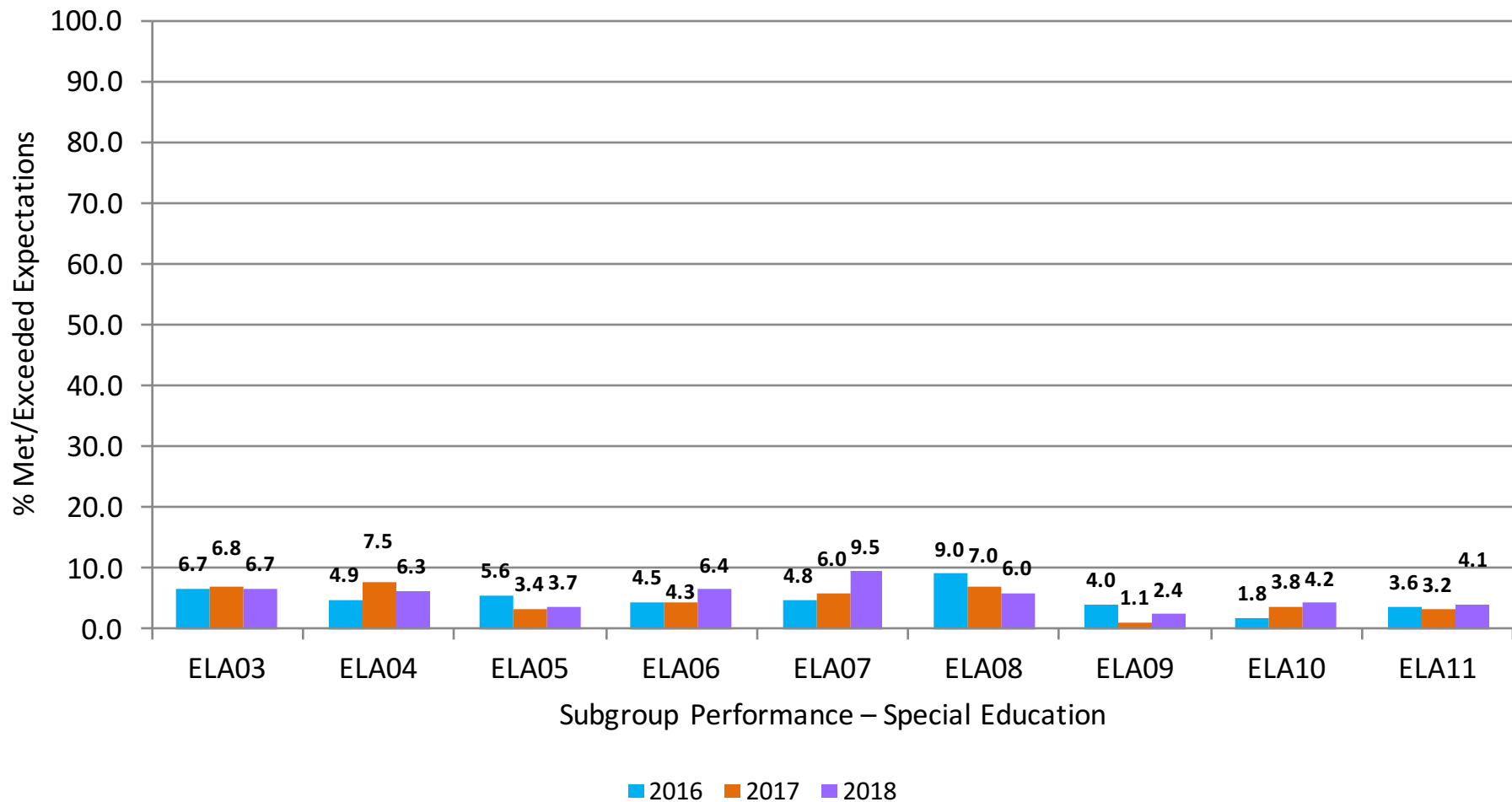

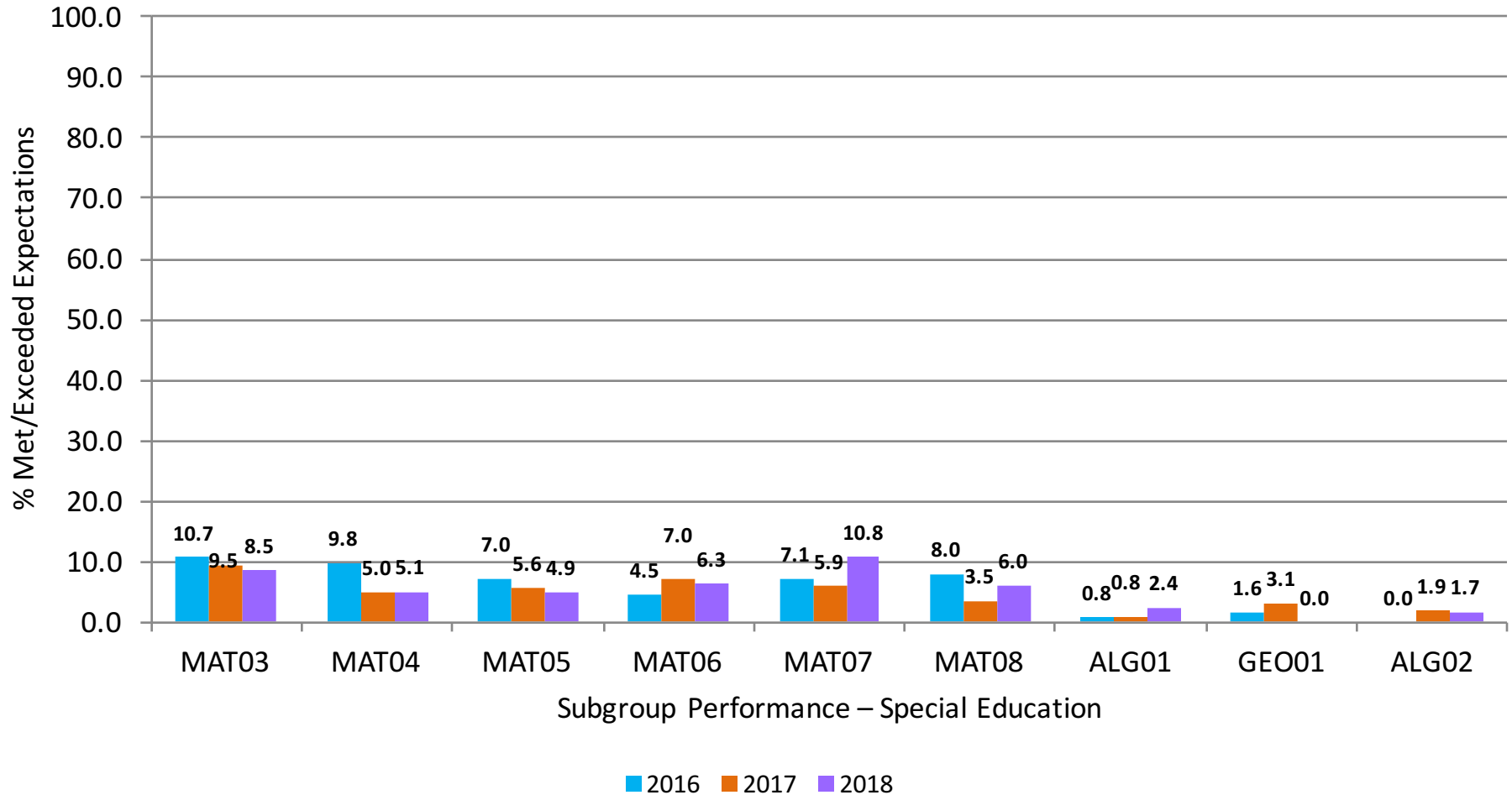

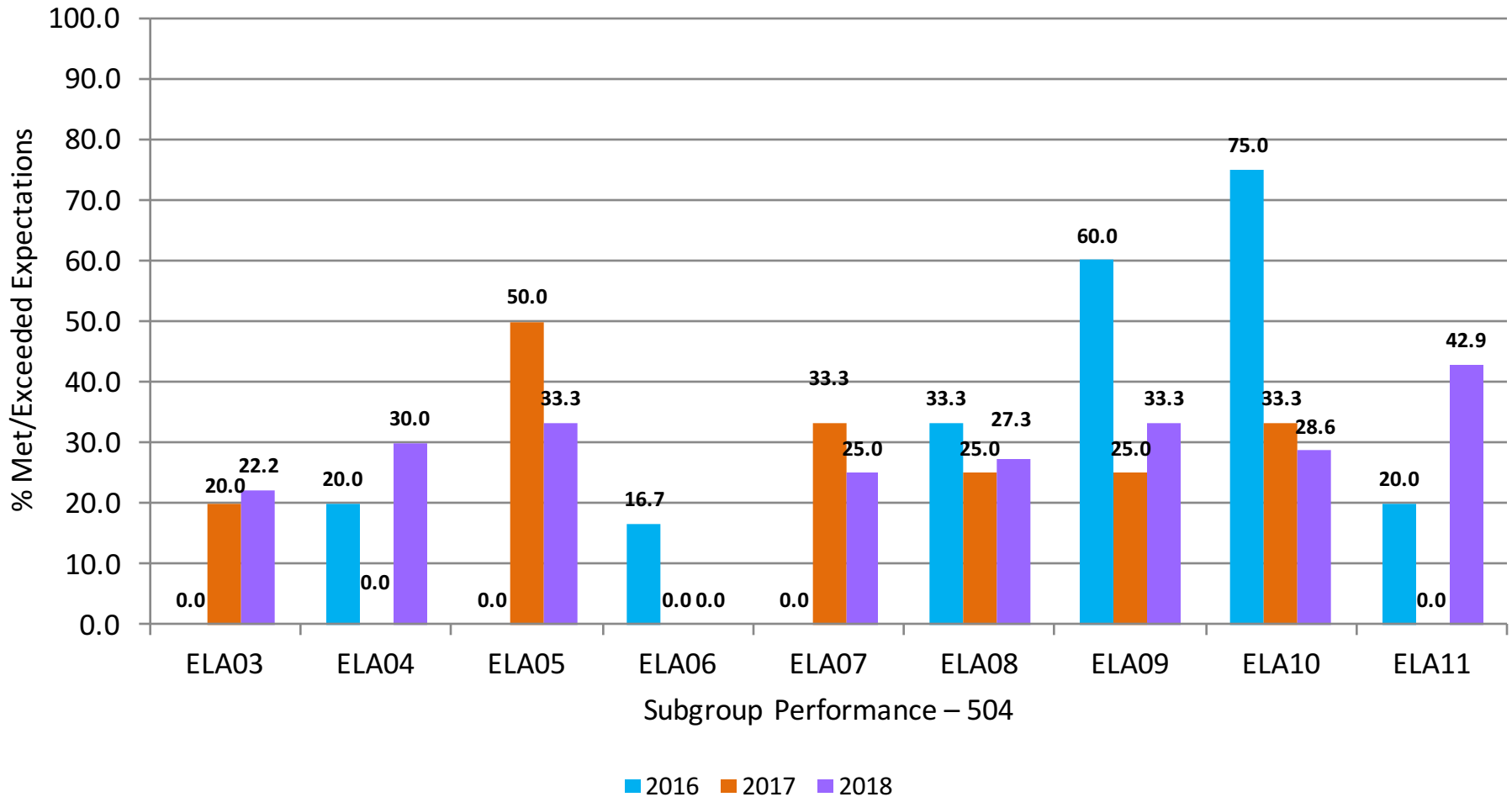
PERFORMANCE OF SPECIAL EDUCATION SUBGROUP OVER 3 YEARS

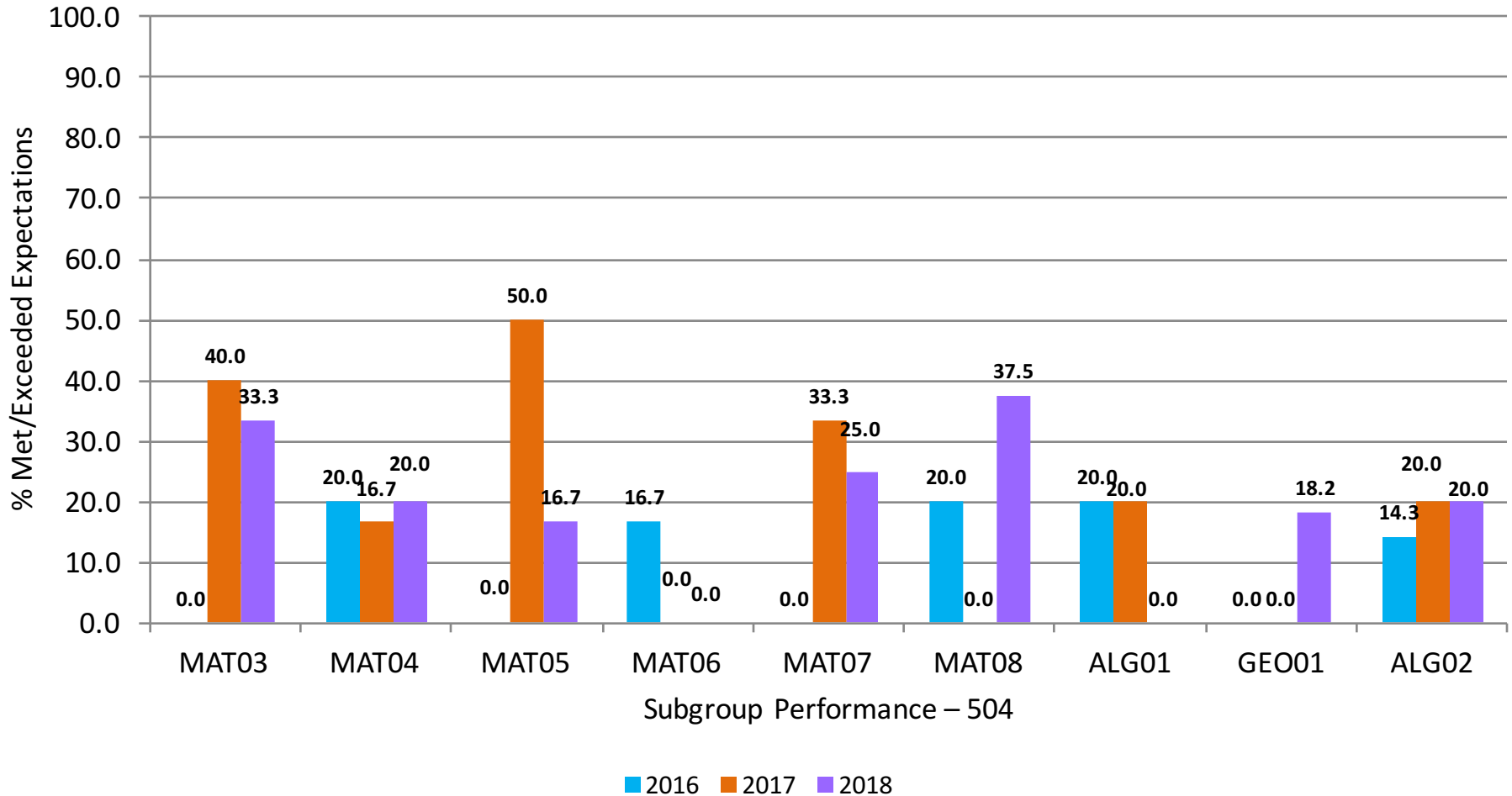

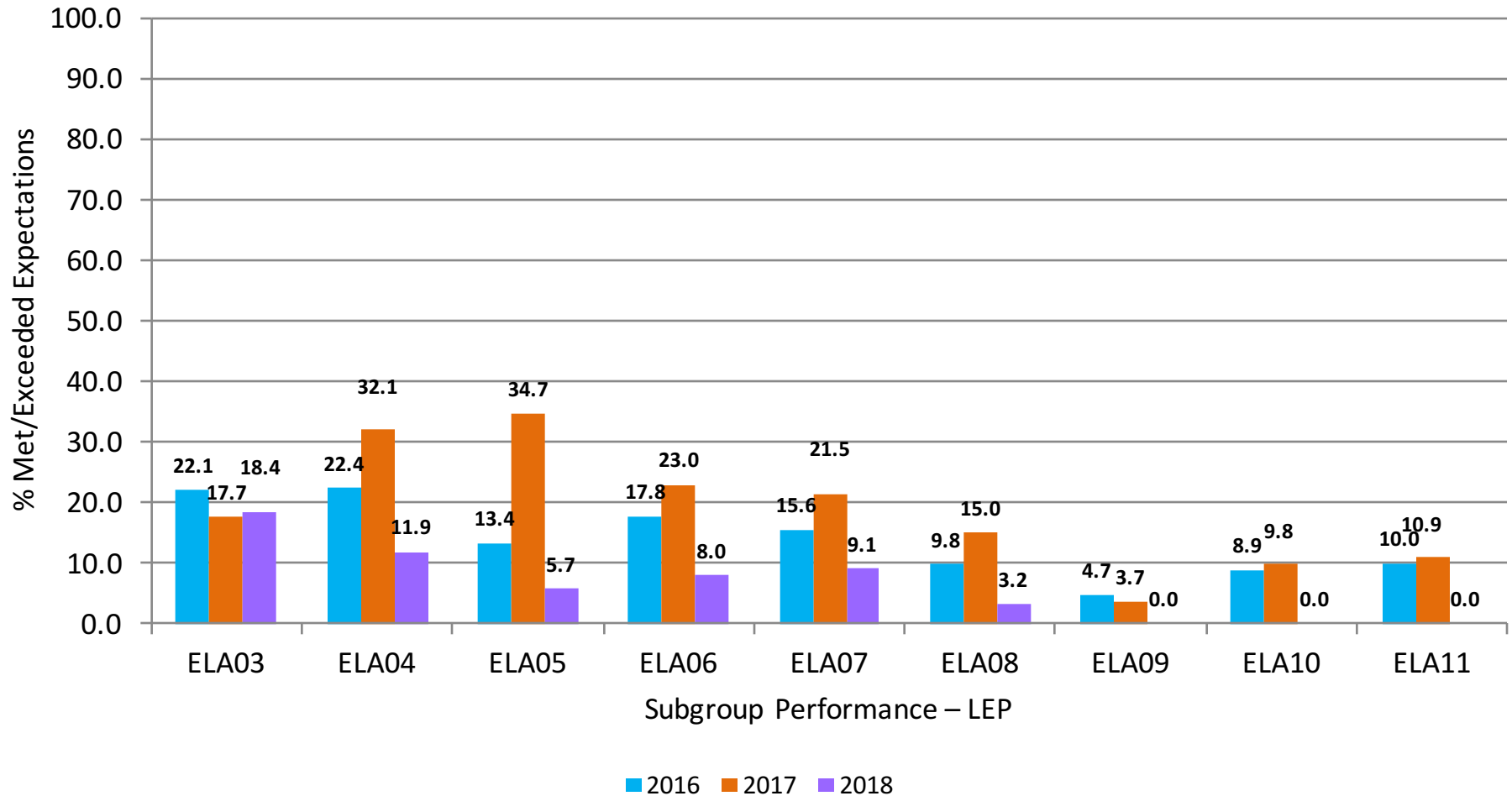

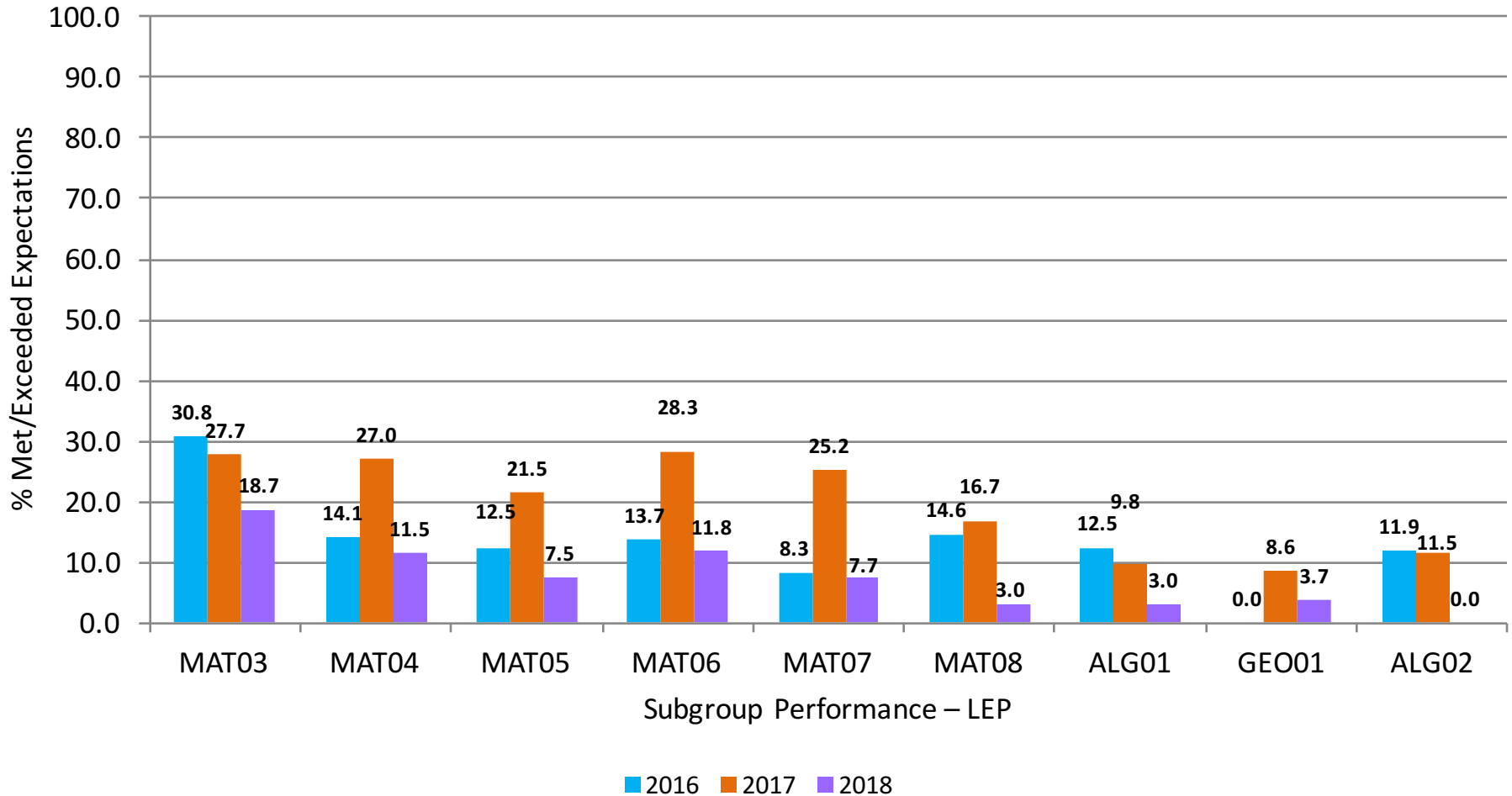

 PERFORMANCE OF LEP SUBGROUP OVER 3 YEARS

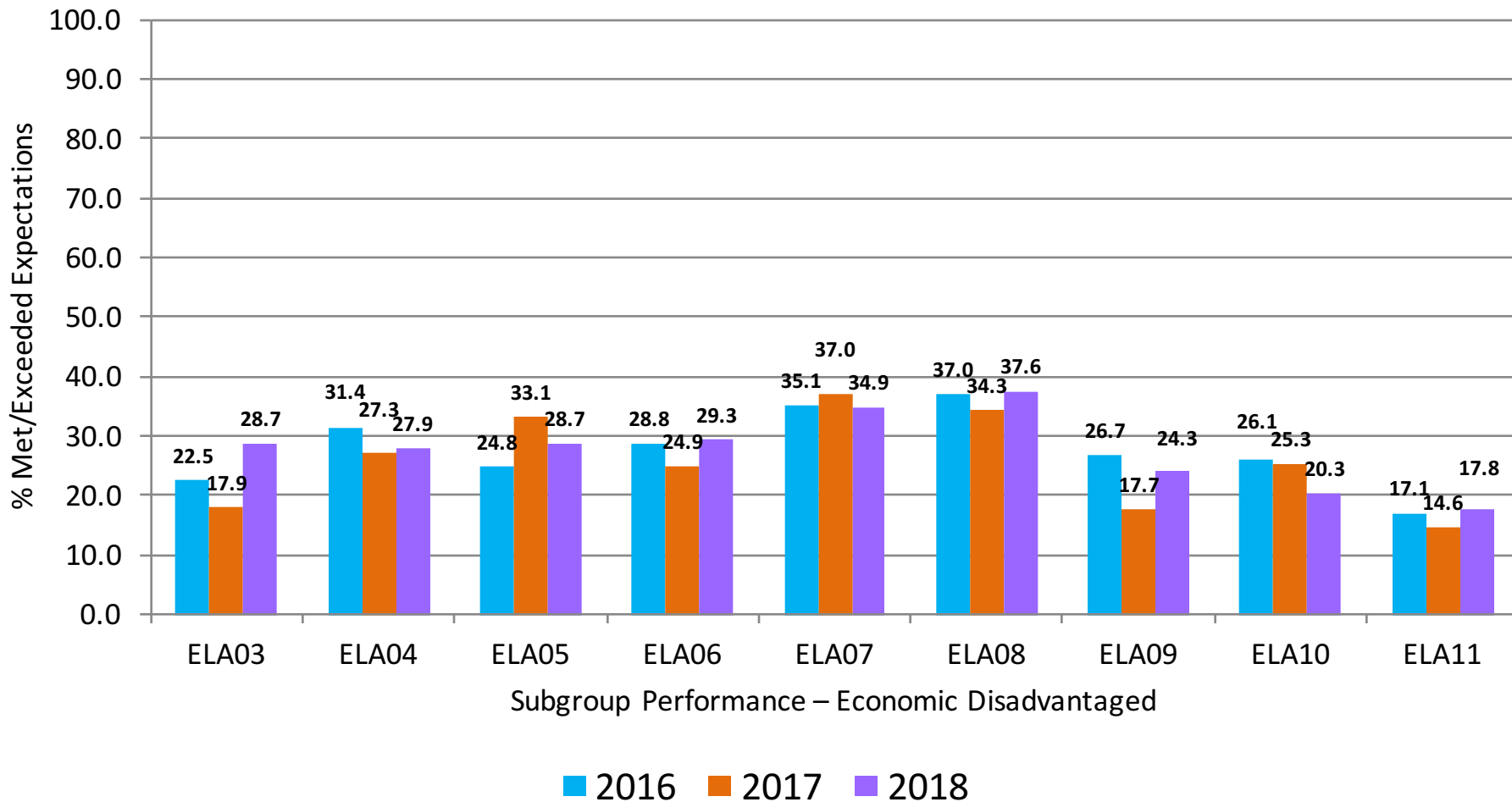

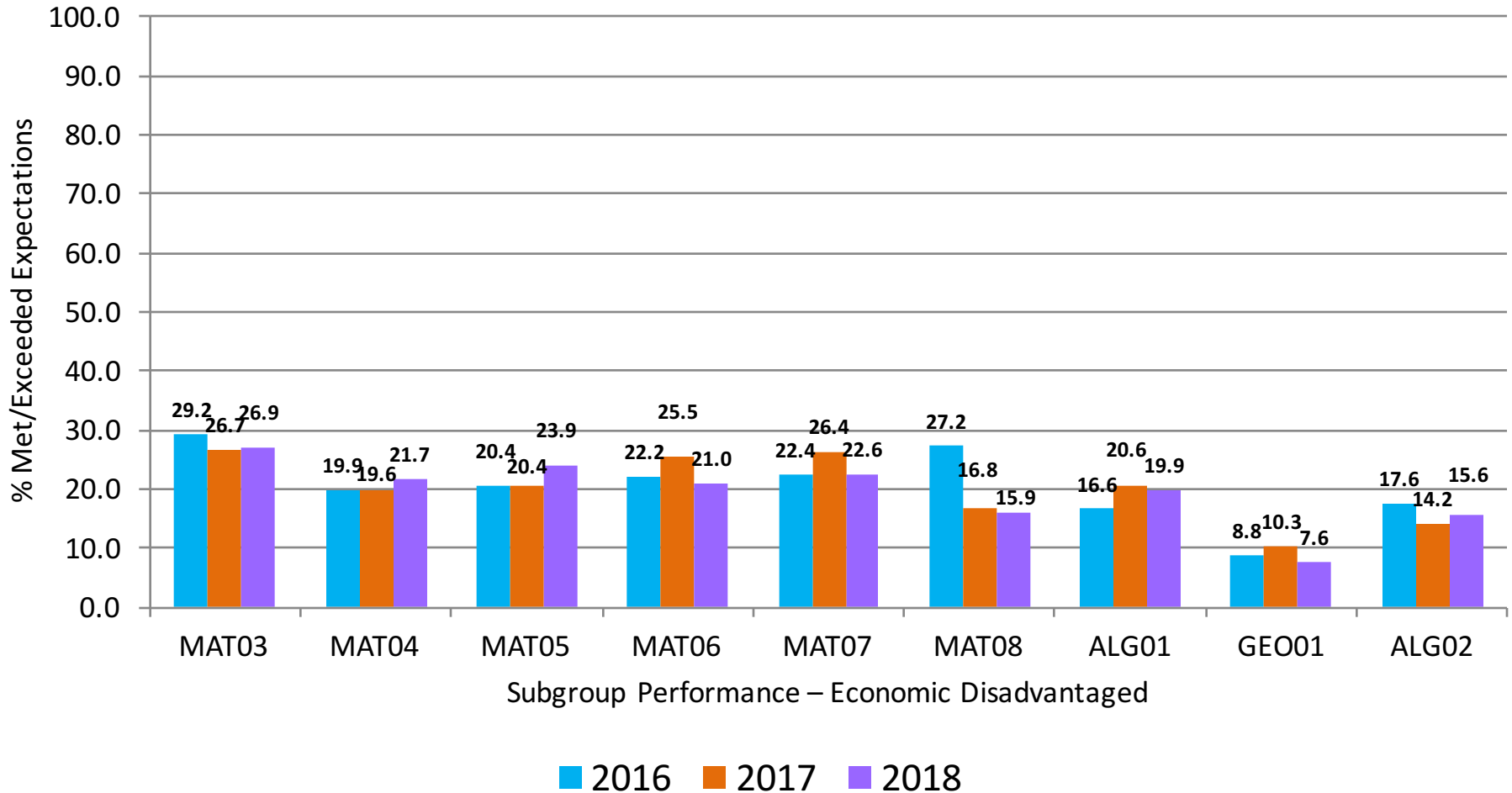

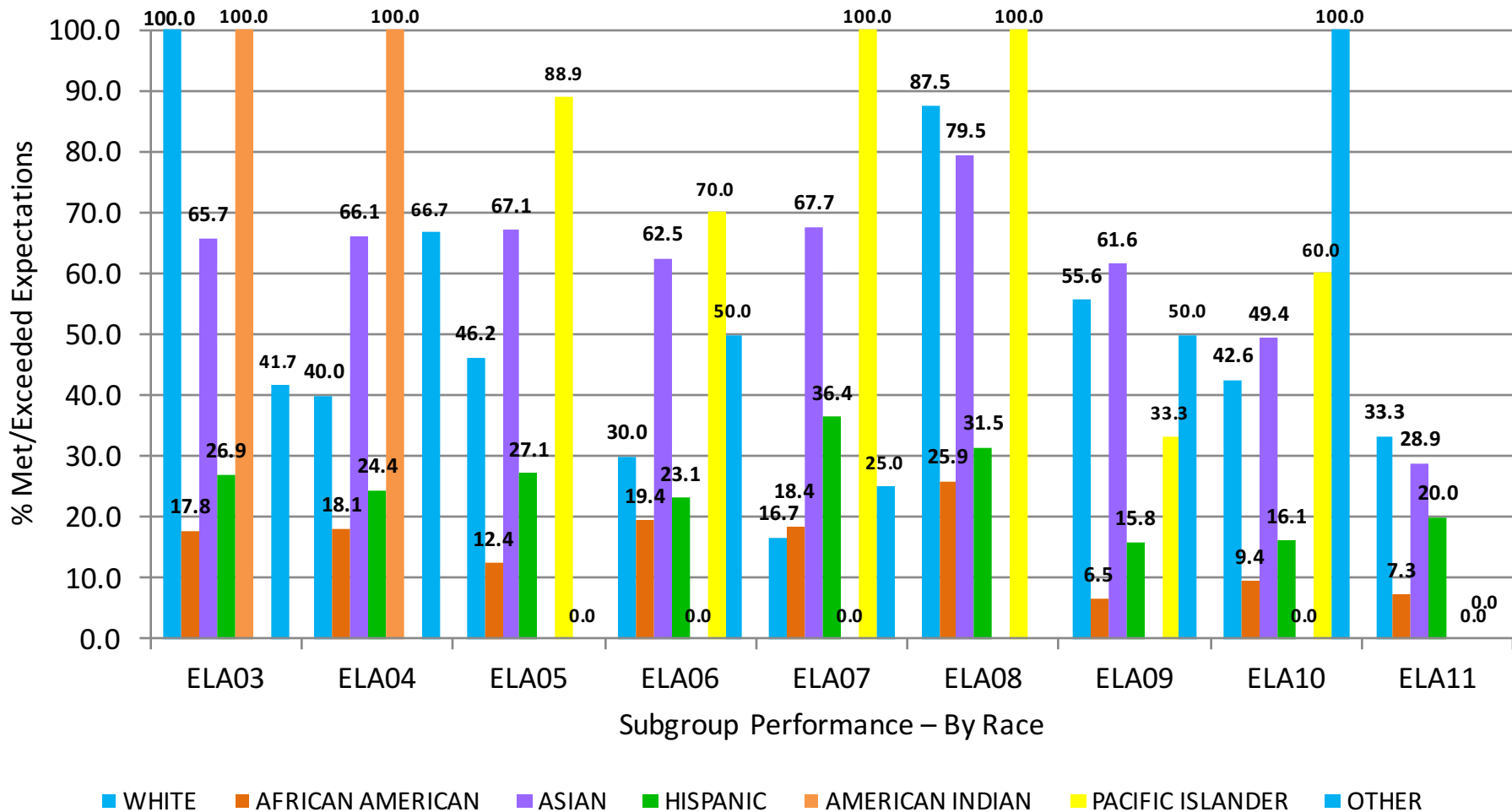
PERFORMANCE OF ECONOMICALLY DISADVANTAGED SUBGROUP OVER 3 YEARS

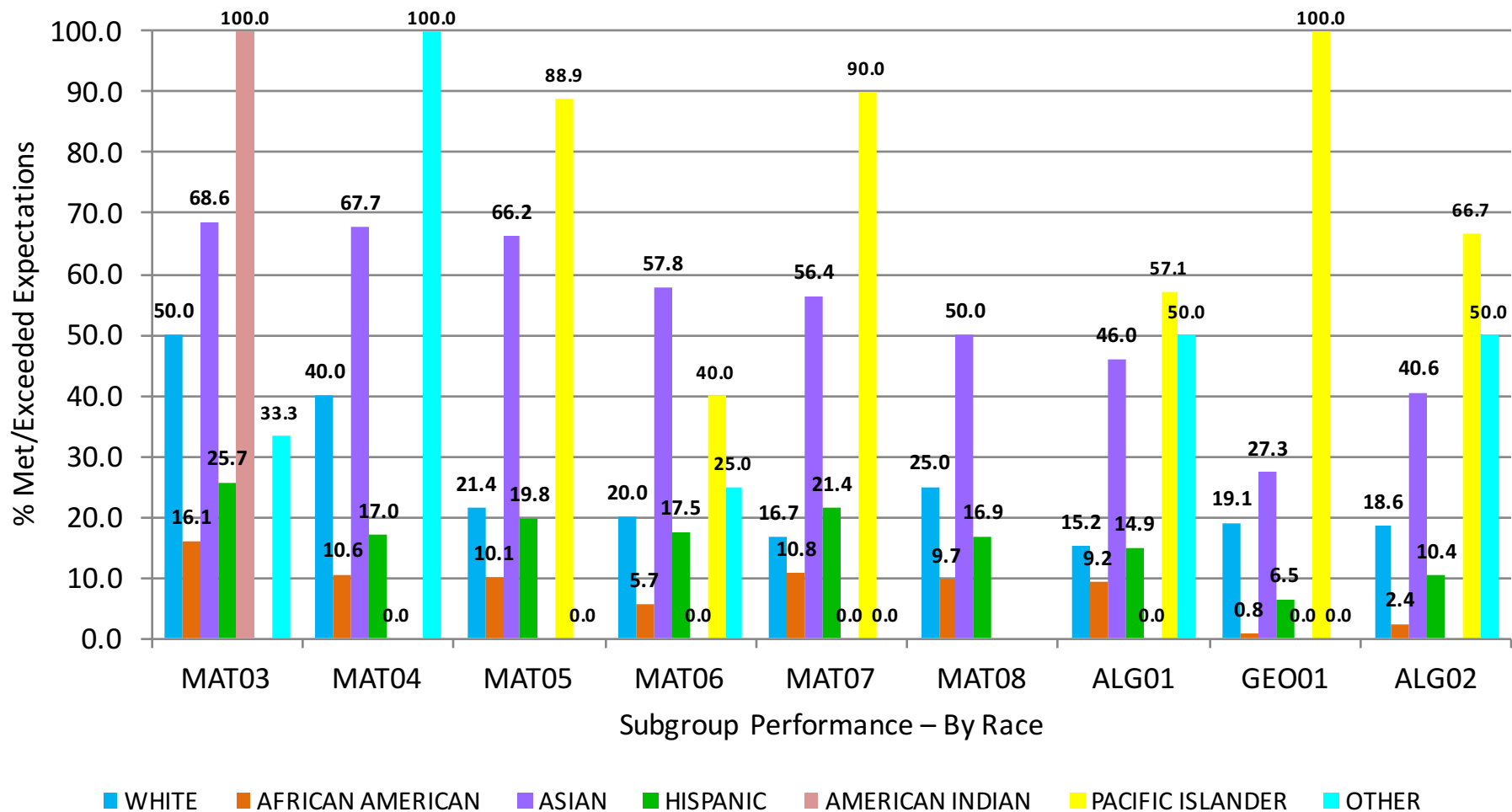
