ACBOE 2023-2024 BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

Total Budget: \$288,811,772

Local Financing:

- Local revenue sources derived from PILOT revenue and Local Tax Levy account for 25.59% of the general fund revenue
- The 2023-2024 budget shows its commitment to the residents of this great city by reducing the general fund local tax levy by \$4M (5.13%)

State Aid:

- State Aid accounts for 39.88% of the 2023-2024 General Fund Budget
- The Atlantic City School District received an increase in State Aid of \$19M for the 2023-2024 school year

Rating Action:

- Standard & Poor's Global Ratings revised its outlook to positive from stable on the Atlantic City Board of Education (BOE), NJ's underlying rating of its general obligation bonds.
- At the same time, Standard & Poor's Global Ratings affirmed its 'BBB'- underlying rating with a positive outlook on the BOE's outstanding bonds.

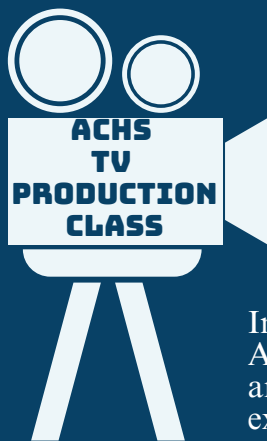

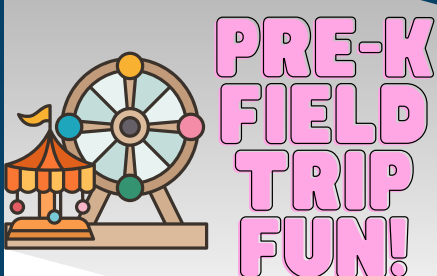
