The Andrew Fisher Scholarship Fund is a \$1,000 award given annually to a student at Atlantic City High School who has excelled in the sciences, and who intends to pursue a college degree in Chemistry, Engineering, Mathematics or a related science. The award is in memory of Andrew Fisher, who died suddenly and tragically on August 28, 2012, while pursuing his degree in Chemical Engineering at Northeastern University in Boston. Andrew graduated from Atlantic City High School in June, 2009.

For consideration, applicants must be nominated by a science faculty member and must complete the application form, including a short essay and a high school transcript. Applications must be postmarked by May 3, 2024 and mailed^{*} to the following address:
