**1.** Approve the 2023/2024 proposed budget for submission to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools as follows:

### **2.** Approve the following:

Whereas, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:11-12 (p), the District Board of Education is required to establish a maximum travel expenditure amount for the budget year that may not be exceeded; and

Whereas, the District Board of Education has determined that the maximum travel expenditure amount will include all travel that is supported by federal, state, and local funds; and

Whereas, the District Board of Education has determined that the total maximum travel budget for the general fund for the 2023/2024 school year is \$50,000 and the District has spent \$23,974.81 as of 3/10/2023.

Whereas, the District Board of Education has determined the maximum travel budget for Federal Funds to be \$75,000 for the 2023/2024 school year. The projected travel amount is projected to be the same for the 2023/2024 school year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the District Board of Education hereby establishes the maximum travel amount for the 2023/2024 general fund budget is \$50,000.

- 3. Resolution to amend the Long Range Facility Plan (LRFP) to increase the amount for the purchase of an Administration Building by \$6.5M.
- 4. Resolution to amend the Long Range Facility Plan (LRFP) to add the renovation of the Indiana Avenue School to accommodate a warehouse/district inventory facility at projected cost of \$3M.

On a motion made by Mr. Johnson and seconded by Mrs. Bailey, the Atlantic City Board of Education voted to approve Goods & Services 1 – 4. At the call of the roll the vote was as follows: Mrs. Bailey-yes; Ms. Bridgers-yes; Mrs. Byard-yes; Mr. Chowdhury-yes; Mr. Johnson-yes; Mr. Mayfield-yes; Mr. McKinley-yes; Mr. Steele-yes. Of eight members present, eight voted in the affirmative. The motion carried.
